This position is responsible for new program development. This includes arranging workshops (photography, art, wood carving, etc.) themed around the Niagara Escarpment and executed at the Centre or its satellite centre in north Flamborough (Valens Community Centre). The coordinator will look at new program ideas designed to draw visitors to the Centre. This position works closely with the newsletter editor, website crew and Directors.

Volunteers receive free entry to the Dundas Valley Conservation Area and assistance with transportation may be available. Co-ordinator positions may also be asked to attend monthly Directors meetings, and are asked, if available, to volunteer a shift each month at the Centre, although it is not a requirement.
