Volunteer Coordinator

To move forward in a positive direction and grow to meet our potential, the Giant's Rib Discovery Centre (GRDC) is looking for individuals enthusiastic about the Niagara Escarpment World Biosphere Reserve, its preservation and interpretation to the public. Training will be provided.

The GRDC is open from 10 to 3 on Saturdays and Sundays. Volunteers are required in order to cover 2 shifts each day (9:30 – 12:30 and 12:30 – 3:30). The volunteer co-ordinator is responsible for assisting in **recruitment**, then **scheduling volunteers** to cover shifts each month. The volunteer co-ordinator is also responsible for volunteer **training and recognition**. It is advised that the coordinator also take one shift at the Centre each month to remain in touch and aware of changing needs.

Duties of the Centre Volunteers include:

- Speaking to visitors and introducing them to the Centre
- Set up or take-down of certain display items and merchandise
- Knowledge of the Artist of the month on display at the Centre
- Knowledge of GRDC programs and services
- Learning about the Niagara Escarpment
- Learning about partner organizations and functions
- Assist or lead hikes from the Centre (optional)
- Assist in June Summer Solstice fundraiser

Volunteers receive free entry to the Dundas Valley Conservation Area and assistance with transportation may be available. Co-ordinator positions may also be asked to attend monthly Directors meetings, and are asked, if available, to volunteer a shift each month at the Centre, although it is not a requirement.
